1. In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioner is that the annual increments for which the petitioner is entitled for, have not been extended to him which is causing prejudice to the petitioner.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that as per his instructions, keeping in view the entries in the service book, all the increments for which the petitioner is entitled for keeping in view the punishments which have been imposed, have already been extended to him and assertion that the increments have not been released is incorrect.

5. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, in one case, the punishment of stoppage of increment was imposed but in appeal, the same was withdrawn for which, no increment has been released to the petitioner.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the petitioner has any grievance qua any non-release of the increment and the petitioner raises the said grievance by way of representation, the said representation will be decided in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such claim by passing appropriate speaking order.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate representation.
