1 By way of present petition filed under Article 226 of
the Constitution of India, petitioners are seeking issuance of directions to
the official respondents to protect their life and liberty at the hands of
respondents No.4 to 8.

2 Notice of motion.

3 On the asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG,
Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

4 As per the petitioners, they have married on 14.02.2024 against
the wishes of respondents No.4 to 8, who happen to be the family members
of petitioner No.1.

5 Both the petitioners have claimed themselves to be major
relying upon their Aadhar Cards indicating that petitioner No.1-Baljinder
Kaur is 1987 born and petitioner No.2-Gurpreet Singh is 01.01.1994 born.

6 Without commenting on the legality and validity of the marriage, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 15.02.2024 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioners.

7 Keeping in view the fact that both the petitioners claim to have married, I think that if possible, respondent No.2 may call a meeting of the petitioners as well as respondents No.4 to 8 in his presence, so that the parties get rid off their ill feelings and live amicably.

8 The petition stands disposed off.
