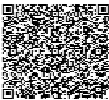

JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 20.03.1996 (Annexure P-9) and 23.07.1997 (Annexure P-10) whereby authorities under Payment of Gratuity Act has rejected his claim for gratuity.

2. The petitioner joined respondent No.1 as workman on 01.02.1964. His services came to be terminated w.e.f. 31.12.1991. He preferred an application before Controlling Authority seeking release of gratuity. The said application came to be dismissed vide order dated 20.03.1996 (Annexure P-9) passed by Controlling Authority. He preferred appeal before Appellate Authority which came to be dismissed vide order dated 23.07.1997. Hence present petition.



3. Learned counsel for the petitioner expressed his inability to controvert the findings recorded by Controlling Authority and Appellate Authority.
4. From the perusal of record, it is evident that both the authorities below have recorded concurrent findings. There is no jurisdictional error or manifest illegality warranting interference.
5. Dismissed.
