This writ petition was filed seeking a direction to the Chandigarh Industrial and Tourism Development Corporation Limited, the respondent herein, to grant regular pay scale to the petitioner with effect from 06.05.1994 along with arrears and interest thereon.

No interim order was granted in this writ petition. When the matter was referred to the Lok Adalat, it was found that the petitioner is no longer residing at the address furnished in the memorandum of parties.

There is no representation for the petitioner or her learned counsel when the matter is taken up for hearing. It is therefore clear that the petitioner is no longer interested in pursuing this case. The writ petition is accordingly dismissed for non-prosecution.
