1. The petitioner in the instant (second) petition is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.133 dated 12.06.2023 under Sections 332, 353, 333, 307, 506, 34 of the IPC and Sections 21(b) of the NDPS Act (Sections 27-A, 29 of the NDPS Act and Sections 120-B, 114 of the IPC added lateron) registered at Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar.

2. On a pointed query put to the learned counsel for the petitioner as to what was the material change in circumstances after the dismissal of previous petition filed under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. seeking similar relief on 22.12.2023, he has failed to bring to the notice of this Court any material change in circumstances. Therefore, no ground is made out to extend the extraordinary concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

3. Accordingly, the instant petition is hereby dismissed.
