VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to implement the order dated 10.06.1994 (Annexure P-12) passed by respondent No. 2 and other prayers have also been made in the present petition.
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that the matter is of the year 1997 and no interim order has been passed in favour of the petitioner. She has further submitted that the petitioner has already been given *ad hoc* promotion on the post of Head Constable and double promotion cannot be given and thus, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said aspect inspite of the report of the registry that the counsel for the petitioner has been informed.
4. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present case or to file a fresh petition, in case, any cause survives to him.
