DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.546 dated 04.11.2022 registered under Sections 120-B, 364-A, 386, 406, 418, 420 of the IPC registered at Police Station Pundri, District Kaithal.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that compromise has already been effected amongst the parties. Learned counsel has also drawn attention towards order dated 28.07.2023 passed by this Court in CRM-M-18369-2023 (Annexure P-4), whereby co-accused Avtar Singh was allowed bail on the ground of compromise. Learned counsel further contends that complainant- Amrit Pal Singh has made a statement before the Trial Court *qua* various co-accused regarding the compromise effected between them. Learned counsel also submits that compromise is oral but the same has been effected with the petitioner also.

4. Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. AG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent- State; whereas Mr. D.S. Virk, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of complainant and filed his power of attorney.
5. Learned counsel for complainant does not dispute the factum of compromise. He further submits that he has no objection for grant of bail to the petitioner on the basis of compromise.
6. Learned State counsel has placed on record the custody certificate revealing that petitioner is in custody for the last 01 year 03 months and 03 days.
7. Having regard to the above facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
