1. In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioner is that the petitioner had filed writ petition bearing CWP No.28658 of 2017, which was disposed of on 29.04.2022 with regard to his claim for promotion to the post of Superintendent w.e.f. 21.06.2010 instead of prospective effect.

2. While disposing of the said writ petition as infructuous, liberty was given to the petitioner to raise the said claim before the authorities concerned and the petitioner had raised the said claim by filing a representation dated 18.07.2022 (Annexure P-13) and thereafter vide representation dated 29.08.2023 (Annexure P-16).

3. The grievance of the petitioner is that the said claim is not being taken to the logical end and the same is kept pending.

4. Keeping in view the facts mentioned in the present writ petition, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representation dated

29.08.2023 (Annexure P-16) within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will also be extended to him otherwise, due reasons be given for not accepting the claim of the petitioner and the same be informed to the petitioner as well.

5. The present writ petition is disposed of in above terms.
