1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondents to absorb them as Constables from the date their juniors have been absorbed as Constables.
2. The petitioners were appointed as SPOs on ad hoc basis. A number of SPOs like petitioners were appointed during 1990 to 1994. A number of writ petitions came to be filed before this Court seeking absorption as Constables. The petitioners are also seeking absorption as Constables.
3. Learned State counsel submits that all the petitioners except petitioner No.6 have already been absorbed as Constables and petitioner No.6 has been discharged from service, thus, present petition has rendered infructuous.
4. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel, the present petition stands disposed of. The petitioner is at liberty to move an appropriate application, if something survives.
