The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for quashing the order dated 19.02.1998 (Annexure P-2) passed by Respondent No.1, vide which Respondent Nos.2 to 5 have been promoted as Field Officer /Accounts Assistant ignoring the petitioners and writ of mandamus directing Respondent No.1 to consider and promote the petitioners on the said post(s) from the date, when Respondent Nos.2 to 5 have been promoted, with all consequential benefits.

At the outset, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that despite her best efforts, she has not been able to get further instructions from the petitioners in the matter.

In this view of the matter, the instant petition is hereby dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to seek revival of the same in case anything still survives.
