The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents No.3 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondents No.6 to 9 and for direction to respondent No.3 to decide the complaint dated 09.10.2023 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondent No.3 to look into the complaint dated 09.10.2023 (Annexure P-3), within a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents No.1 to 5.

Without adverting to the merits of the case and in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is

disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the complaint

dated 09.10.2023 (Annexure P-3) and decide the same by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
