1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not pressing this petition qua regularization of his services under the Policy dated 07.03.1996 (Annexure P-1) but submits that as the petitioner is continuing for the last 37 years, he is entitled for regularization of his services under the Policy dated 01.10.2003 keeping in view the direction given by this Court in CWP No.2158 of 2020 titled as ***Ashish Sharma and others vs. State of Haryana and others***, decided on 13.03.2024.



2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any representation is received from the petitioner raising claim based upon ***Ashish Sharma's case (supra)***, the same will be given consideration and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such claim and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner keeping in view the parameters laid down in ***Ashish Sharma's case (supra)***, the benefit will be granted, otherwise speaking order will be passed giving the reasons for not accepting the claim.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submit that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file a fresh representation raising a claim for regularization under the Policy dated 01.10.2003.
