This is the second petition filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in a case arising out of FIR No.249 dated 05.06.2023, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 325, 307, 427, 447 and 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Sirsa, District Sirsa. The earlier petition bearing CRM-M-3605-2024, was dismissed as withdrawn by this Court on 23.01.2024 by passing the following order:-

“Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.249 dated 05.06.2023 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 325, 307, 427, 447 & 506 of the IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. AG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent- State whereas Mr. Manvinder Sidhu, Advocate filed his power of attorney on behalf of complainant.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that other injured Nepal was caused as many as 09 injuries out of which injury on the head of Nepal with kapa is attributed to the petitioner.

At this, statement is made by learned counsel for the petitioner, so as to withdraw this petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn, as prayed for.”

3. After going through the aforesaid order and after hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court does not find any ground, so as to entertain the second petition.

Dismissed.
