The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release of the alleged detainee namely Shalu (wife of the petitioner), who is stated to be in illegal confinement of private respondents.

Status report by way of affidavit of Umed Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kaithal (HQ) has been filed by learned State Counsel, the same is taken on record. Copy of the same has been supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State Counsel has informed the Court that the alleged detainee has been recovered from Lucknow by the police party of police Station Sadar Kaithal on 30.04.2024. As per the recorded statement of alleged detainee i.e. Annexure R-1 which is annexed with the status report along with Memo of Custody as Annexure R-2 on

which date has been inadvertently mentioned as 1.4.2024 instead of 1.5.2024, the alleeged detenue is 22 years old and with her own will is living with one Vinod r/o Village Padla. She has further stated that she does want to live with the present petitioner.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take all other remedial measures including filing of petition under Section (9) of Hindu Marriage Act for restitution of conjugal rights as per law.

Allowed as prayed for.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
