LISA GILL, J.

1. Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing notice dated 15.02.2020 (Annexure P-6) issued under Section 13 (4) of Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002.
2. None had appeared on behalf of petitioner on last two occasions when this writ petition was taken up for hearing.
3. Following order was passed on 19.01.2024.

“Following order was passed when this writ petition was taken up for hearing on the last occasion:

Learned Counsel for the respondents points out that though amount of Rs.1.5 lakh was deposited in terms of order dated 26.02.2020, petitioner has not deposited any further amount and neither has approached the respondents with a proposal for One Time Settlement. Respondents are unable to proceed due to interim order dated 26.02.2020. Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 16.10.20203.

In case there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the next date of hearing and arguments are not addressed, interim order in favour of the petitioner shall automatically stand vacated.”

Today again there is no representation on behalf of petitioner.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 27.02.2024.

Interim order granted in favour of petitioner stands vacated.”

4. Today again there is no representation on behalf of petitioner.

It appears that he is not interested to pursue the matter any longer.

5. Writ petition is dismissed in default and for non-prosecution.

6. Pending application(s), if any, stand(s) disposed of accordingly.
