1. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 CrPC, prayer has been made for issuance of directions to official respondents No.2 to 5 to decide the representation dated 01.12.2023 to conduct fair, transparent and thorough investigation and for taking strict appropriate legal action against the private respondents.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case direction is issued to the respondents to decide the representation (Annexure P-9) moved at the instance of petitioner by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

3. Prayer seems to be justified.

4. Upon advance notice, Mr. Kewal Singh, Additional AG, Punjab appears on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5 and raises no objection to the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

5. In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed

of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur to look into the representation (Annexure P-9) and take appropriate action in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 04 (four) weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. The aforesaid direction shall not be treated as an expression of opinion on the merits of the averments made in the representation.
