RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 02.09.2023 passed in CWP-19403-2023.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 02.09.2023 passed in CWP-19403-2023 has since been complied with and after inquiry, the complaint filed by the complainant has been ordered to be filed. Necessary report dated 04.04.2024 produced by the counsel for the respondent in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
