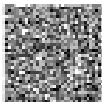

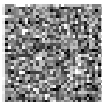

SHEEL NAGU, C.J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner being an aspirant of Ph.D. in Public Administration, who is aggrieved by the fact that he has been denied admission to the said course by respondent-University.
2. The relevant rules and regulations prescribe that minimum 50% marks in interview are necessary to secure admission, besides other necessary requirements.
3. Undisputedly, the petitioner scored only 12 marks out of 30 marks in the interview, which is less than 50%.
4. The provision that mandates securing 50% marks in the interview to be considered eligible has not been challenged by the petitioner.
5. This Court does not find any illegality or perversity in the action of respondent-University in denying admission to petitioner.



- 6. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
- 7. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
