1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of Award dated 15.02.1999 (Annexure P-5) whereby he was awarded compensation of ₹10,000/- however, was not reinstated.
2. Learned State counsel submits that as per his instructions, petitioner has passed away, thus, the prayer with respect to reinstatement does not survive. The State with respect to back wages was directed to pay lump sum ₹10,000/-. The said amount if not paid would be paid to LRs of petitioner.
3. As per office report, counsel for the petitioner has been informed, however, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. Matter is pending before this Court for last more than two decades.
4. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel and absence of representative of petitioner, the present petition stands disposed of.
