1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to her in case FIR No.522 dated 31.10.2023, registered under Sections 306, 34 of IPC (Offence under Section 411 IPC added later on), at Police Station Division No.7, Ludhiana.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 26.02.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Prem Chand, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 09.03.2024 and is no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 26.02.2024, passed by this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
