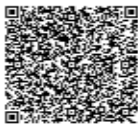

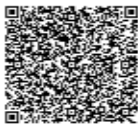
The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 28.02.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
