- 1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C with a prayer to quash the FIR No.07 dated 18.01.2017, under Sections 323,324,325,452,427,379-B,148 and 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Rawalpindi, District Kapurthala and all other subsequent proceedings arising out therefrom on the basis of compromise deed dated 24.01.2019 (Annexure P-2)
- 2. The Registry of the Court had raised objections on 21.02.2019, however, no learned counsel had collected the paperbook for removal of the objections. It seems that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present petition.
- 3. Consequently, the petition is ordered to be dismissed.
