1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to restore the family pension of the petitioner with all consequential benefits, in view of circular No.504 dated 17.01.2013 (Annexure P-6) issued by the Defence Authorities, which was stopped in the year 1987 and to pay the arrear from due date till its payment with interest @ 12% per annum.
2. After arguing the case for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to file a fresh one, on the same cause of action, with better particulars and by impleading the necessary parties.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
