1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 05.12.2023 passed in CWP-27305-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of the respondent has been filed today in the Court. Same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 05.12.2023 passed in CWP-27305-2023 has been complied with and speaking order dated 29.02.2024 has been passed.

5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
