MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.0012 dated 07.01.2023 for the offences under Sections 120-B, 34, 35, 406, 417, 420, 426, 465, 467, 468, 471 of the IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Hisar Sadar, District Hisar.

2. On 27.02.2024, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel inter alia contends that a perusal of the allegations leveled in the FIR makes it abundantly clear that a civil dispute is being twisted and given a criminal colour. It has also been submitted that identically placed co-accused have already been extended the concession of bail by this Court vide order dated 14.09.2022. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner is

willing to join investigation and cooperate with the Investigating Agency.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 27.02.2024, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. She, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 27.02.2024, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
