The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing the letter dated 30.03.2000 (Annexure P-25), vide which the PUNSUP Staff has been directed to give wheat gain of 1 Kg in case of covered godowns and 700 grams in case of open storage of wheat stock. Further seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to implement the earlier instructions dated 16/20.02.1995 (Annexure P-14), which was challenged earlier vide writ petition No.8332 of 1998.
2. Mr. Abhishek Khullar, Advocate for Mr. J.S. Jaidka, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 and filed memo of appearance, which is taken on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous in view of the order passed in **CWP-6705-2002** titled as ***Sital Singh Versus State of Punjab and others*** and other connected matters, decided on 29.08.2013.
