1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to consider and promote the petitioner as Sub Divisional Engineer on the post falls under the quota Sectional Officer/AMIE from the date the quota post falls vacant for promotion and grant other relief.
2. It has been submitted by learned counsel for respondent No.2 that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has already been promoted to the post of Sub Divisional Engineer in September, 2008 and thereafter, he has taken Voluntary Retirement Scheme (VRS) on 31.08.2008; respondent Nos.3 & 5 have retired on 31.03.2019 and respondent No.4 has retired on 31.03.2006 (Premature retirement). He further submits that the petitioner is now settled abroad, which fact has not been denied by the counsel for the petitioner.
3. In this view of the matter, nothing survives to be adjudicated in the present writ petition and the same has been rendered infructuous.
4. Disposed of as having become infructuous.
