LISA GILL, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing show cause notice dated 13.11.2017 (Annexure P-3), letter dated 03.02.2018 (Annexure P-5) and decision/letter dated 07.05.2018 (Annexure P-8) issued by respondent-Bank.
2. Learned counsel for respondent-Bank while referring to e-mail dated 30.05.2023, copy of which is taken on record, subject to just exceptions, submits that this writ petition is rendered infructuous as petitioner's account was settled and closed on 30.09.2021.
3. Learned counsel for petitioners had sought an adjournment on the last date of hearing to inform about the latest status of matter. Today, despite matter being called twice, none appears on behalf of petitioners.

4. Be that as it may, in view of the categoric statement made by learned counsel for respondent-Bank, we find no ground for continuation of present proceedings.

5. Writ petition is accordingly disposed of as infructuous. In case, any incorrect fact has been placed before us, petitioners are at liberty to file appropriate application within four weeks.
