1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the action of the official respondents in appointing/posting/absorbing the private respondents in the posts of Deputy Controller (Finance and Accounts) and for quashing the order dated 30.04.1998 (Annexure P-7). Further seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to fix the seniority of respondent No.5.
2. Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that during the pendency of the present petition the petitioners as well as respondents No.5 to 7 have already retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation and with the efflux of time, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous. However, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that liberty may be granted to the petitioners to revive the present petition, if any cause still survives.
3. Disposed of as having become infructuous with the liberty as aforesaid.
