Main Case

This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating the contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 08.01.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-24523-2021.

The nature of order, qua which the contempt is asserted by the petitioner is of such that to assess whether any contempt has been committed qua the said order or not, a lot of disputed questions would be required to be adjudicated upon. However, adjudication of the disputed question of facts would not be in the domain of the Contempt Court. Hence, the present petition is dismissed.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
