AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner has filed instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.166 dated 21.08.2023 (P-1) under Sections 379-B, 34 of IPC (Later-on added Section 411 IPC) registered at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.
2. As per facts of case, FIR was registered on statement of Gurdeep Singh, who stated that on 20.08.2023 at about 10 am he was returning home on his motorcycle after withdrawing cash of Rs.8,000/- from Bank of India ATM. When he reached near Mohalla Guru Nanak Nagar little ahead of girls school village Gill one car stopped in front of him from which three persons got down armed with weapons. They gave him fists blow and snatched cash of Rs.8,000/- along with his mobile phone and managed to escape in their car towards village Gill. Said car was bearing registration No.PB-10-DQ-2372. With these allegations, present FIR has been registered.



3. Learned counsel for petitioner pointed out that matter has been compromised with complainant. He has also joined investigation. He was arrested on 05.10.2023. Challan in this case is already presented. He will abide by the terms of bail order. He has also referred to CRM-M-31261-2024 regarding quashing of FIR in which order has been passed by this Court on 04.07.2024 for recording of their statements.

4. Learned counsel representing State confirmed that after completion of investigation, challan has been presented. It is also confirmed that matter has been compromised between the parties.

5. Considering aforesaid factual position, no purpose would be served by keeping petitioner behind the bars. Therefore, without expressing my mind, regular bail filed by petitioner is allowed. He is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Judge concerned.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
