SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

1. The jurisdiction of this Court under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been invoked for issuance of a Writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for appointment of a Warrant Officer for the release of the detainee namely Archana (daughter of the petitioner), who is stated to be in illegal confinement of respondent No.4.
2. This Court while considering the instant petition on 02.04.2024 directed the State to produce Archana and Rakesh Kumar, who are petitioners in CRWP-1725-2024.
3. Today, the alleged detainee namely Archana is present in Court alongwith boy namely Rakesh Kumar with whom she is alleged to have been solemnized marriage on 04.04.2024 as per Hindu Rites and Ceremonies and also

preferred a petition bearing No. CRWP-1725-2024 seeking protection of life and liberty under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, supported with a certificate issued by Purohit.

4. The petitioner namely Mahaveer, father of alleged detainee Archana was allowed to meet her in Court itself and they have communicated well with each other for more than one hour. At this stage, he submits that he does not have any objection to the relationship of alleged detainee with Rakesh Kumar and is ready to accept the said marriage.

5. In the light of above, nothing survives in the present petition, hence the same is disposed off, having been rendered infructuous.
