On 15.05.2024, the following order was passed:-

“On 29.02.2024, the following order was passed:

“The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of the order dated 14.08.2023 (Annexure P-6) whereby non-bailable warrants of arrest has been issued against the petitioner in case title as State Versus Gurdit Singh arising out of FIR No.23 dated 25.01.2022 registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on 27.07.2023, the petitioner moved an application for exemption which was allowed. However, later, the counsel for the petitioner did not intimate the petitioner about the next date of hearing i.e. 14.08.2023 on which date the petitioner did not appear and the impugned order came to be passed. He states that he is ready and willing to join proceedings once again.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today subject to a deposit of Rs.25,000/- as costs with the Sadhna Society for the Mentally Handicapped, Near Housing Board Chowk, Raen Basera Building, Manimajra, Sector 13, Chandigarh and on his doing he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner does not have enough money to deposit Rs.25,000/- as costs.

In view of the contention raised by the petitioner, the amount to be deposited is reduced to Rs.10,000/- as costs.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is again directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today subject to a deposit of Rs.10,000/- with the Sadhna Society for the Mentally Handicapped, Near Housing Board Chowk, Raen Basera Building, Manimajra, Sector-13 and on his doing so he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.

Adjourned to 19.07.2024.

In deference to the aforementioned order, the petitioner has surrendered on 22.05.2024 and has since been released on interim bail. The said fact is agreed to by the counsel for State.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

It is expected that the petitioner shall not absent himself from Trial without sufficient cause.
