1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 22.09.2023 passed in CWP-20734-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Krishan Lal, District Development and Panchayat Officer, Karnal, filed in the Court today, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 22.09.2023 passed in CWP-20734-2023 has been complied with and speaking order dated 02.05.2024 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
