1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to grant additional increments on completion of 24 years and 32 years service as Constable.
2. Learned State counsel pointing out affidavit dated 23.10.2006 of Commandant 82nd Battalion, P.A.P. Chandigarh submits that petitioners have already been given the benefit of placement in the next higher pay scale and proficiency step up under the ‘Assured Carrier Progression Scheme’. The relevant para of the affidavit is reproduced as below:

“3. That, all the Govt, employees are getting the benefit under “Assured Carrier Progression Scheme”, whose overall service record is adjudged as good. The petitioners and others filed this Civil Writ Petition are also having good service record and covered by the revised instructions stated above and they have also been given the benefit of placement

in the next higher pay scale and proficiency step up under the “Assured Carrier Progression Scheme.”

3. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that with the efflux of time, petitioner has lost his interest to pursue the matter.
4. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
5. The petitioner is at liberty to move an appropriate application, if something survives.
6. Pending misc. application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
