1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of cross case GD No.029, dated 17.04.2023 (Annexure P-2) under Sections 326, 452 of IPC at Police Station Sultanwind, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar in case FIR No. 187 dated 31.12.2022 registered under Sections 323, 341, 365, 377, 379-B, 506, 148, 149 of IPC, at Police Station Sultanwind, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 15.02.2024 (Annexure P-3).

2. Vide order dated 26.02.2024, this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Magistrate for getting their statements recorded with respect to the compromise dated 15.02.2024 (Annexure P-3).

3. Pursuant to aforesaid order, the parties have appeared before the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar and got their statements recorded. Report dated 14.03.2024 has been received whereby after recording the statements of the parties, the Court below has shown its satisfaction that the compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. I have heard counsel for the parties and gone through the case file.

5. In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court below and considering the offence for which the accused have been charged are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out the differences for betterment of future life of the parties and also in view of the law laid down in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the present petition for quashing the FIR is allowed qua the petitioner.

6. Resultantly, cross case GD No.029, dated 17.04.2023 (Annexure P-2) under Sections 326, 452 of IPC at Police Station Sultanwind, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar in case FIR No. 187 dated 31.12.2022 registered under Sections 323, 341, 365, 377, 379-B, 506, 148, 149 of IPC, at Police Station Sultanwind, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 15.02.2024 (Annexure P-3) are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
