NAMIT KUMAR, J.

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the order dated 20.12.1995 (Annexure P-11) passed by respondent No.1, whereby appointment of the petitioner has been set aside.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from respondent No.1, submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has already been promoted as Salesman on 01.05.2007 and retired as such on 31.12.2022. He further submits that respondent No.3 has unfortunately died and the said fact has already been recorded in the order dated 21.03.2007.

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of time, the relief claimed in the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
