The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* to set aside the impugned order dated 21.07.1988 (Annexure P-2) passed by the learned Special Collector, Agrarian, Ferozepur, order dated 28.10.1991(Annexure P-3) passed by learned Commissioner, Ferozepur Division, Ferozepur and order dated 16.09.1996 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Financial Commissioner, Appeals (II), Punjab.
