1. Prayer in the present criminal revision petition is for setting aside the order dated 06.03.2020, passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram, whereby the appeal filed by the respondent-wife under Section 29 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005; against the judgment dated 12.03.2018, passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurugram;

has been partly allowed and the petitioner-husband has been directed to pay the monetary benefit to the respondent-wife.

2. Mr. Amit Jain, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent and filed his memo of appearance, which is taken on record.
3. No such order has been passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Gurugram as well as the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram, which is criminal in nature, as such, the present petition, filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is not maintainable, in view of the decision passed by this Bench in petition bearing No. CRM-M-58023-2023, titled “Gautam Singal vs. Anju Singal”, decided on 30.11.2023.
4. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed being not maintainable.
5. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail remedy as per law.
6. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
