Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned action of respondent No.6 who without passing any resolution of the Gram Panchayat has blocked the on going Gar Mumkin Khad and diverted the entire rainy water into the land of the petitioners, the same being wrong, illegal, null and void and against the principles of natural justice with a further prayer to take a final decision upon the legal notice dated 05.01.2024 (Annexure P-6) served by the petitioners upon the respondents within stipulated period.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the redressal of their grievances, petitioners have served a legal notice dated 05.01.2024 (Annexure P-6) upon respondents No.1 to 3 but the same has not been decided by the respondents till date.

On asking of Court, Mr. Navneet Singh, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, respondent No.3-The Deputy Commissioner, Hoshiarpur is directed to decide the legal notice dated 05.01.2024 (Annexure P-6) served by the petitioners expeditiously in accordance with law, preferably, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
