This is an appeal filed by the claimant against the quantum of compensation granted vide the impugned award dated 04.10.1993 passed by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Chandigarh, vide which she has been awarded compensation of ₹50,000/-.

It is a burnt case.

As per the report of the Registry, notice issued to the appellant has been received back unserved with the report that she has left the place long time ago.
