Prayer in this writ petition filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the order/instructions dated 3rd June, 1998 (Annexure P-3) and for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to implement the order/instructions dated 14th May, 1997 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner had stated on 21.04.2017 that the petitioner has died and sought time for impleading his legal representatives. He submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to get instructions from the legal representatives of the petitioner.

In this view of the matter, the instant petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to LR's of the petitioner to revive the present petition in case any cause still survives.
