The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.413 dated 25.11.2023 registered under Sections 379, 411 IPC at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 27.02.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A short reply dated 01.04.2024 by way of an affidavit of Shamsher Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Faridkot has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. She on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 27.02.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
