The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.80 dated 24.03.2023 registered under Sections 379B(2) & 34 of the IPC (Section 411 of the IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

2. As per prosecution allegations, on 24.03.2023, complainant Inder Singh along with Surinder Singh and Umedh were going home, when they were waylaid by three youths on motorcycle. One of them gave datar blow and then they took away ₹4,000/- from the complainant. FIR was lodged against unknown persons but later on, supplementary statement was made on 25.03.2023 that complainant Inder Singh could identify the snatchers.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn attention towards the testimony of complainant Inder Singh made during trial, in which though

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he proved the occurrence but clearly stated that accused present in the Court (who included the petitioner), was not the same person who had commit the snatching. Learned counsel further contends that co-accused Vishal Singh @ Vishal @ Kalu has already been allowed bail by this Court vide order dated 05.02.2024 passed in CRM-M-50757-2023 (Annexure P-2).

- 4. Notice of motion.
- 5. Mr. Sahil R. Bakshi, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent- State.
- 6. The custody certificate placed on record by learned State counsel reveals that petitioner is in custody for the last 11 months and 01 day and involved in more case.
- 7. Having regard to the above facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
