1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of Award dated 29.07.1998 (Annexure P-15) whereby Labour Court had ordered to reinstate the workman with full back wages.
2. On 16.07.2004, the following order was passed:
“This is an application for directing the respondent-Management to comply with the provisions of Section 17-B of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947.
Counsel for the petitioners states that the respondent-workman has already retired and, hence, is not entitled to any last drawn wages in terms of the provisions of Section 17-B of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947.
The application is dismissed.”
3. Mr. Vikas Singh, counsel for the petitioner submits that he has no instructions.
4. Dismissed with liberty to move an appropriate application, if cause survives.
5. Pending misc. application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
