1. Through the instant petition, prayer has been made for issuance of directions upon the learned trial Court concerned/Special Court (Companies Act, 2013), Gurugram, to decide the regular bail application of the present petitioner, which according to him is pending for the last five months.

2. This Court has gone through all the *zimni* orders as annexed with the present petition, and a perusal of the same specifically reveals that it is the petitioner who is not advancing arguments on the said bail application. Therefore, in such circumstances no direction can be passed upon the learned trial Court concerned/Special Court concerned.

3. Consequently, the instant petition is **dismissed**. However, it is always expected from the learned trial Court concerned, to decide all pending regular bail applications expeditiously.
