On 26.02.2024 the following order was passed:-

“ *The Prayer in this petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for the quashing of the FIR No.0547 dated 06.09.2022 under Sections 406, 420, 506 IPC registered at P.S. Ambala Cantt., District Ambala and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 29.12.2023 (Annexure P-2) entered into between the parties.*

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in order to live peacefully, parties have entered into Compromise dated 29.12.2023 (Annexure P-2) according to which, both the parties have agreed not to proceed further with the FIR in question.

Notice of motion for 22.07.2024.

Mr. Kanwar Sanjiv Kumar, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.1-State of Haryana whereas Mr. Arvind Kumar Yadav, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.2 and has filed his power of attorney. He does not dispute the above said compromise, which has been arrived at between the parties, according to which, complainant does not wish to press the allegations alleged in the complaint any further.



Keeping in view the above, the parties are directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording of their statements on 01.04.2024 with regard to the compromise dated 29.12.2023 (Annexure P-2) by moving an appropriate application or by presenting this order. The Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate is directed to submit the report on or before the next date of hearing containing the following information:-

- 1. Number of persons arrayed as accused in the FIR;*
- 2. Whether any accused is a proclaimed offender;*
- 3. Whether the compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence;*
- 4. Whether the accused persons are involved in any other FIR or not; and*
- 5. The Trial Court is also directed to record the statement of the Investigating Officer so as to know how many victims/complainants are there in the FIR and all the victims/complainant as well as accused are party to the compromise in question.*

The petitioners shall deposit a cost of Rs.25,000/- with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association Account No.65035682434 State Bank of India, High Court Branch, IFSC Code SBIN0050306 on or before the date of recording of their statements and produce the receipt of the same to the Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate.

As per report dated 19.07.2024 of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ambala the accused did not appear to get his statement recorded in terms of the aforementioned compromise order though the complainant had appeared and got recorded his statement.

In view of the above, present petition is dismissed.
