1. The present petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for willful and deliberate disobedience of order dated 12.10.2023, passed by this Court in CWP 23067-2023.

4. Counsel for the respondent has submitted that the order qua which the contempt is asserted, has since been complied with and, therefore, the present petition may be dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

6. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

7. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left un-addressed, they would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
