The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for seeking direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6 stating that they are harassing and humiliating them but no action is being taken by the official respondents No.2 to 4 including Director General of Police, Punjab, Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, Station House Officer, Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner though lays much stress to the alleged occurrence as detailed in para Nos.4 and 5 of the present petition with the support of videography/CD attached to the petition as Annexure P-3, captured in CCTV camera installed in the surrounding area/neighborhood but the respondent-police authorities are sitting tight over the issue.

In the light of the above, the present petition is disposed of with
a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated

19.02.2024 (Annexure P-4) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

However, Registrar (Listing) is directed to ensure that at the time of filing of such petitions, the counsels be asked to place on record the still photographs in colour along with the CCTV footage/pen drive, if that is being relied upon in the pleadings qua the cause of action.

Without complying with the above direction, no petition shall be entertained by the Registry at the time of filing of such petitions.
