1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to decide the appeal of the petitioner dated 08.03.2019 (Annexure P-4).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had filed a petition bearing CWP-10625-2022 (Annexure P-8), decided on 18.05.2022, vide which a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court had set aside the orders dated 10.08.2021 and 30.11.2021 and the appellate authority was directed to restore the appeal filed by the petitioner to its original number and status and dispose of the same on merits, in accordance with law. In support of his arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner has referred to the zimni orders to show that although the case had been listed for arguments on several dates, but the same has not been

decided till date. It is stated that counsel for the petitioner, before the appellate authority would fully coordinate in the expeditious disposal of the appeal.

3. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the appeal dated 08.03.2019 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioner, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case and respondent No.2 would consider and decide the matter independently, in accordance with law.
